



GENERAL INFORMATION



The Pharmacy Services Program at Köyceğiz Vocational School of Health Services, will commence education in the 2021-2022 academic year with a quota of 40 students.

Our school has a total of 11 academic personnel, 3 of which is employed at the Pharmacy Services Program, 5 management personnel and 1 temporary personnel and 1 permanent supporting personnel. A total of 18 personnel both academic and management is employed.

Our school has 844,24 m² building, 4 classrooms, 1 seminar room (capacity of 100 students), 9 offices and 90 m² laboratory.

Educational activities in the Pharmacy Services Program will be carried out theoretically and practically in laboratories.



THE OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM





THE DEPARMENT COURSES



In the program, the students are required to take and successfully pass the courses worth 120 ECTS credits minimum for graduation.

The average GPA (Graduate Point Average) must be at least 2.00 out of 4.00

The students who successfully complete the requirements for graduation are awarded the diploma indicating the associate degree of Pharmacy Technician.

The graduates can find employment in private, public and government sectors. They can work especially in pharmacies of public or private, hospitals, medical and pharmaceutical industry. It is estimated that our country has a number of 24.000 pharmacies and medicine related companies (the pharmacies located in the hospitals owned by the government or private companies, the distribution companies for medicine and health, pharmaceutical factories) in which our grates can find the opportunities for employment and play roles as supporting personnel.

It is proposed by some people that our country has a demand for Pharmacy Technicians, a total of 35.000, currently. If the need stands and is realized, our graduates can find jobs relatively easily in the sectors aforementioned.

THE OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE THE EXAM TO 4-YEAR COLLEGE: VERTICAL TRANSFER EXAM DGS



The selected graduates of our program can take an exam called DGS (Vertical Transfer Exam) to pursue a 4 year (Bachelor Degree) in some degree programs shown below. The students are encouraged to examine «ÖSYM Dikey Geçiş Yönetmeliği» (DGS) for details pertaining to this transfer. The 4 year degree programs that accept our graduates are:



INTERNSHIP



Our students are required to conduct a mandatory internship that should last at least 30 days at the end of their first years usually in summers in the institutions, companies or places related to Pharmacy Services.

Hence, the students will be able to put into the practice the education and knowledge they have acquired during their classes.
